A welcoming community

Regardless of the challenges, our parish community flourishes. We have 1,074 families that call St. Pius X home. Volunteers coordinated phone calls and welcome packets to 26 new families who joined our parish. We continue to livestream Masses, prayer services, presentations and send the e-newsletter to 700 families!



Ready to share our gifts

We contacted 125 parish seniors by phone and mailed out 435 health packets. The Prayer Shawl Ministry distributed over 30 blessed shawls during the month of October and 50 boxes of fresh produce were delivered to Families in Action in South Omaha.

Working for justice and service to one another

Human Needs Outreach offered pantry services to 300+ families and distributed over \$10,000 in rent and utilities assistance. The Women's Organization provided care packages for those living in care centers while 40 Confirmation youth served throughout the Omaha community. Over the summer, a prayer service was held for Racial Justice.

We celebrated 21 baptisms, 44 reconciliations. 3 weddings and hosted 19 Funerals

PRAYER

60 parishioners praying weekly for the prayer line. We continue to provide 30 First Communions, at-home seasonal prayer resources and special services like the Prayer Service for Remembrance.

EDUCATION

Currently, there are 625 students attending St. Pius X / St. Leo School and 50 children participating in our **Religious Education** program.
