Finance Council A sincere thank you to all who responded to Fr. Joe's letter appeal for end of year fiscal year donations and to all who supported the Parish Festival. The new parish fiscal year begins July 1st and with the new fiscal year we renew our plea to the online givers to review your giving level and consider increasing the monthly contributions. We also renew our plea to those who are not online givers to consider signing up for automatic monthly or weekly contributions. All you need to do is sign a form authorizing your financial institution to implement those automatic transfers. *Estate Planning Note:* IRA owners age 70½ or over have an option to transfer up to \$100,000 to charity tax-free each year. These transfers, known as qualified charitable distributions or QCDs, offer eligible older Americans a great way to easily give to their favorite charity. Moreover, for those who are at least 72, QCDs count toward the IRA owner's required minimum distribution (RMD) for the year. QCDs can be made electronically, directly to the charity, or by check payable to the charity. However, an IRA distribution, such as an electronic payment made directly to the IRA owner, does not count as a QCD. Likewise, a check made payable to the IRA owner is not a QCD.

Electronic Contribution Offertory Cards are Back - Those who contribute online are invited to take electronic giving cards from the basket in the narthex to put in the baskets at the offertory. This small gesture of giving, even if only a card saying, *"I gave at the office!"* reminds us of our ongoing personal responsibility for our parish community and serves as a witness to our children who see us giving to the Church.
