St. Pius X Religious Education 2024-2025

Religious Education is a lifelong, holistic, developmental process that happens primarily in the home and is supported by the Wednesday evening Religious Education Program at St. Pius X Parish.

The program uses a mix of monthly in-person, home, and small group sessions for children and adults.



Twice monthly in-person sessions: Once each month, children meet in a classroom by grade-level with a catechist. Parents meet in the school for an adult formation presentation by lay parishioners or videos on the month's topic. A second time each month, families can gather at the parish to do a "home" session together as a way to encourage and support each other while learning together.



Family sessions at home: The other 2 weeks of each month, families with children in Levels 1-6 use the Family Formation packets (handed out each month at the group session) or sacramental preparation materials (for Level 2). The Church recognizes that parents are the first and most important teachers of their children in the practice of the faith. The parish community offers parents support them to help them fulfill their responsibility.

Confirmation preparation: Youth who are preparing for the sacrament of Confirmation meet with a catechist by grade level twice each month. During Lent, they will focus on some kind of group project for the parish or community. The youth use Decision Point materials from Dynamic Catholic.





Opportunities for discipleship service and support: Service is a hallmark of Catholic identity. Each family receive a Family Discipleship Diary with ideas on how to practice works of mercy throughout the year. Families can work together to perform the monthly works of mercy or they can share ideas and encouragement to help keep the home sessions on track in spite of busy schedules.
