

DISCOVER YOUR SPIRITUAL GIFTS THIS LENT!

St. Bernard Catholic Community is offering two series of Lenten workshops for Parishioners, family and friends to explore God's call. The first is scheduled for 3 Thursday mornings, and the second will be held on 3 Tuesday evenings.

These Called by the Spirit workshops will help you answer questions such as:

- > What are spiritual gifts? Does everybody have them?
- > What does the Bible say about these gifts? Are Patron Saints involved?
- > Has God gifted me personally? If so, what are my spiritual gifts? Do I have a Patron Saint for my gifts?
- > How can I use these gifts in my daily life? Are there any opportunities for my gifts, right here in the Catholic Church?
