Health Ministry News, June is Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness Month. According to the Alzheimer's Association, it's never too early – or too late—to take charge of your brain health. Research evidence is strongly showing that social engagement, regular physical activity, and heart health maintenance can reduce that decline.
